

THOUGHT FOR CORPUS CHRISTI (18/19th June): Corpus Christi reminds us that the presence of Christ is perennial and that he abides with us daily under the form of bread and wine. This presence, in the reserved sacrament, is rightly adored. But its main purpose is so that the sick may be joined with the wider community of believers through receiving Communion.



First Reading: (Gen 14:18-20). Melchizedek, a pagan priest-king, gives the gifts of bread and wine to Abraham. In Christian tradition that bread and wine were taken to prefigure the Eucharist.

Second Reading: (1 Cor 11:23-26). When we celebrate the Eucharist we do not merely make Christ present, but re-enact the death by which he saved us.

Gospel: (Lk 9:11-17) Jesus provides an extraordinary meal for those who followed him into the desert. In the Eucharist the Church continues the mission of Jesus - teaching, healing and nourishing God's people.

THOUGHT FOR 13th Sunday of the Year (25/26th June): We see how Jesus headed resolutely for Jerusalem even though he knew that death awaited him there. In this we see how faithful Jesus was to the task the Father had given him. Fidelity can be very costly at times. Let us once more renew our commitment to Jesus and our faith.

First Reading: (1 Kgs 19:16-21). Elisha is called to succeed the prophet Elijah.

Second Reading: (Gal 5:13-18). Despite the Galatians' union with Christ and the gift of the Spirit, they still must struggle against the flesh.

Gospel: (Lk 9:51-62). Jesus rejects retaliation and expects wholehearted commitment from his disciples.

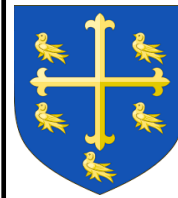

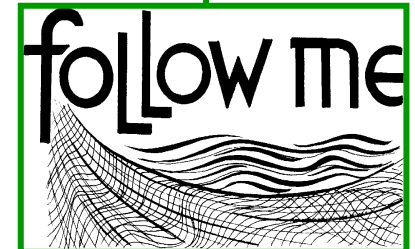
