
#### THOUGHT FOR 14th SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (2nd/3rd July):

It's a very single-minded Jesus who sends out the 72 disciples. They are to preach the Good News, and if people do not accept it, then they are to move on regardless. Are we able to be as confident with our faith today? Or do we find ourselves watering down what we believe so that it seems less radical than it really is?





First Reading: (Is 66:10-14). Written after the return of the Babylonian exile, this poem paints a glowing picture of the blessings God will bestow on Jerusalem and its inhabitants.



☐ Gospel: (Lk 10:1-12.17-20). The sending out of seventy-two disciples.

**THOUGHT FOR 15th SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (9/10th July):** The way we treat our neighbours is an easy gauge to the sort of people we are. The lawyer in the Gospel was looking for an excuse for his own behaviour, yet Jesus makes things very clear: Your neighbour is anyone who needs your help.



First Reading: (Deut 30:10-14). Moses urges the people to obey God's law, not as something imposed from outside them, but as something that springs up from inside themselves.

Second Reading: (Col 1:15-20). Paul asserts the absolute supremacy of Christ.

Gospel: (Lk 10:25-37) The immortal parable of the Good Samaritan.
