

THOUGHT FOR ASSUMPTION OF OUR LADY (13/14th August): The scriptures for today's feast simply underline that nothing in the heavens or on the earth can undo the work of Mary in co-operating with God's plan for our well-being. Assumed into heaven she now enjoys everlasting life. Where she has gone, we hope to follow.



First Reading: (Rev 11:19f). In this vision we have the powers of evil trying to destroy good. Mary was able to bring forth her child who triumphed over the power of death.

Second Reading: (Col 15:20-26). Just as Christ was raised from the dead, so will all people be brought to life through him. Death came through one man, Adam, but life comes through the man, Jesus Christ.

Gospel: (Lk 1:39-56). Mary's first act of service was to visit her cousin Elizabeth. She continued this service for the rest of her life. She still sings the beautiful hymn of praise: 'My soul glorifies the Lord, and my spirit rejoices in God my Saviour.'

THOUGHT FOR 21st SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (20th/21st August):

Every time we think we know the mind of God, we are confounded. God acts in ways which we cannot understand, because unlike God we are predictable. The kingdom of God, says Jesus, will be full of people that we wouldn't expect to see there. But by the same token some people who would feel almost certain of their place may have a surprise when they knock at the door!



First Reading: (Is 66:18-21). Gentiles will be converted and receive a share in Israel's blessings.

Second Reading: (Heb 12:5-7,11-13). As a father shows his concern for his son by training him in discipline, so God trains his children through suffering.

Gospel: (Lk 13:22-30) The Kingdom of God is offered, not just to the Jews, but to people from the four corners of the world.

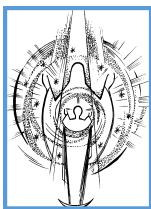

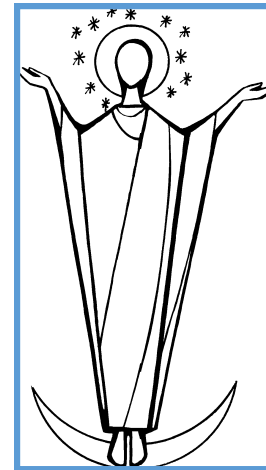
